
### Transnational diffusion to China

- France in Wuhan, Hubei: In March 2014, Chinese President Xi Jinping visited France and signed an agreement concerning the construction of a Sino-French eco-city in Wuhan. The general plan of Sino-French Wuhan Ecological Demonstration City is slated for finalization by August 2015.
- Sweden in Caofendian, Hebei: In 2008, China and Sweden launched a collaboration called the Sustainable Urban Development Cooperation for Caofendian Eco-city. Sweden is also involved another eco-city project in Wuxi
- <u>Singapore in Tianjin:</u> The Singapore government made significant investments in the Sino-Singapore Tianjin Eco City (SSTEC) in 2007
- The UK in Dongtan, Shanghai: Proposed by Arup, a British architecture consultant, the 2005 launch of the Dongtan project was attended by British Prime Minister Tony Blair and former Chinese president Hu Jingtao
- In addition, <u>Finland</u> participated in an eco-city project <u>in Mentougou</u>, Switzerland supported a sister-city eco-city partnership program between <u>Zurich and Kunming</u>; China and the <u>USA jointly developed Huangbaiyu</u> Eco Village; other projects include the <u>Sino-Dutch Shenzhen</u> Low Carbon City project and the <u>Sino-German Eco Park in Qingdao</u>

# Theorizing Transnational Learning— a learner perspective

Social Networking Channel	Informal, personal contact relying on personal relationships and networking	Mostly informal, non-binding, low profile transfer of information between individuals based on trust
Corporate Institutional Channel	Formal, contracted and structured co-operation and tranfer of knowledge between institutions, local or national governments and firms	Binding co-operation that involves both parties as stakeholders

- 1949-78: Russia influence, top 10 buildings
- After 78: seeking for foreigners' consultancies, like Singapore
- After 2000: WTO and Olympics

### Differences:

Coercive learning v.s. voluntary learning

### Similarities:

- China's lacking confidence in old knowledge
- China as a solution for the western spatial fix in capitalism crisis

# Spatial fix for capitalism crisis

### Colonial time

 Western powers need to look for foreign colonies In order to cope with home crisis, like overproduction, underconsumption and trade deficit

### Current time

- Singapore uses China for its Regionalization project
- EU embassies are keen to develop the Chinese market after the 2008 EU crisis









# Local gov't behaviors under AD

### Quota/indicators and cadre management

- In terms of personnel management, upper-level authorities have fully rights to change their local cadres at their one level down.
- Target responsibility system- there is a standardized and systematized evaluation of cadre performance on a wide range of functions at the local level,
- Performance-based appointment system- the greater economic growth, the better chances there are for local leaders to get promotions.

### **Mechanisms of CCP operations**

- vertical subcontracting
  - Level by level
- horizontal competition
  - with their previous and current counterparts
- quota territorialization
  - Assigned upward accountability
  - Some quotas are more important than others: veto, hard, soft



### **Authoritarian Smart I**

- Authoritarian that works not as a direct dominating power, but as a self-governance and self-taming mechanism.
- Smart technologies as "Panopticon" that works as the material base of the authoritarian system



### **Authoritarian Smart II: sesame credit**

- Traditional credit system for finance only
- Sesame Credit for online social behaviors-
  - Credit history
  - Behavior preferences
  - Compliance records
  - Social status
  - Personal networks



### **AS1: Credit for social behavior**

- Humor has it that there might be punishment for low score individuals after 2020
  - e.g. low speed internet; less participation in charity activities; using less online shopping; befriending with lower credits...
- In order to gain higher scores, for better qualities of services, individuals might have to act properly and make proper friends.

#### China's New Social Credit System

been much hoopla in recent Western media outlets about the system, with some viewing it as a return to the dang'an system, which was highly opaque and inaccessible to the individuals and firms being rated. The interpretation of the new policy as an imposition of a "Big Brother" type of invasive tracking system may be largely exaggerated, and how this understanding was arrived at is unclear.

The policy itself states that "records of sincerity," including reports on credit, legal violations, and performance will be kept, although the document, like most state documents is quite vague. The document is extensive, discussing credit in administrative areas, commercial activities, social behavior, and the judicial system. Individuals will hold identification cards associated with credit information, based on financial, industrial and commercial registration, taxes and social security payments, and traffic violations, according to Xinhua. This leaves its implementation open to interpretation.



#### Beijing Journal; Where Each Worker Is Yoked to a Personal File

- **BEIJING** Behind a locked metal grill door on the second floor of the Beijing Engineering Design Institute is a small room stacked with files from floor to ceiling. There is a file here on each of the institute's 600 employees, and although they are never allowed to peek inside, they live all their lives with their file looming over them.
- As part of China's complex system of social control and surveillance, the authorities keep a dangan, or file, on virtually everyone except peasants. Indeed, most Chinese have two dangan: one at their workplace and another in their local police station.
- "Here's one, a man called Ji," Zhang Yuhong, a 34-year-old Communist Party member and dangan clerk at the design institute, said as she skimmed through the loose-leaf binder that served as Mr. Ji's dangan, pronounced dahng-ahn.
- "School records and grade transcripts," she began, offering a foreigner a rare look into the dangan system. "Entry into the Communist Youth League and the Communist Party.







### **China over Mother Nature**

#### Chinese scientists preparing to take on Mother Nature

By STEPHEN WADE The Associated Press

BELJING — As they prepare to play host to the Olympics — an event whose very purpose is to push the limits of human beings — the Chinese are trying to do what man never has: control the weather.

With five months to go before the Summer Games come to Beijing, Chinese scientists say they are confident they can keep rain away from the opening ceremony, or summon a storm on cue to clear the city's choking pollution.

It's a bold — and, according to international scientists, dubious — bit of stage managing, even for a nation that has already shown an outsize ambition to use the Olympics to showcase its

development from rural poverty to economic powerhouse.

China is spending US\$40 billion to remake the infrastructure of the ancient capital, and it already spends an estimated \$100 million a year and employs 50,000 for rainmaking.

At installations like one called Fragrant Hills, outside Beijing, peasants don military fatigues and helmets and squat behind anti-aircraft guns and rocket launchers, blasting the sky with silver iodide, hoping to shock rain from the clouds.

If rain threatens the opening or closing ceremonies, Beijing officials say they will set up several banks of rocket launchers outside the city to seed threatening clouds and cause them to release their rain before it reaches the capital.

"We are now drafting the implementation plan for the artificial rain mitigation for the

opening and closing ceremonies," said Wang Yubin, a Beijing Meteorological Bureau engineer. "This is a very complex process, so we must select the right time and place."

China, short on water and arable land, has lavished some of the scarce resources it has on rainmaking and rain prevention.

Its cloud-seeding weapons include 6,781 artillery guns and 4,110 rocket launchers, according to the state-run Xinhua news agency. The China Meteorological Administration says 4,231 flights for cloud-seeding were conducted from 1995 to 2003.

The Chinese scientists say it worked — increasing rainfall during those years by 210 billion cubic metres, enough to meet the annual needs of 400 million people. China has a population of about 1.3 billion.

Other scientists aren't so sure. "I don't think their chances of

preventing rain are very high at all," said Dr. Roelof Bruintjes, a meteorologist with the U.S. National Center for Atmospheric Research, who was in China several weeks ago and told topranking Chinese scientists he was skeptical.

"If there is really a weather system that is producing rain, they won't be able to do anything. We can't chase away a cloud, and nobody can make a cloud, either."

The argument is about much more than precipitation theory. The Olympics, set to run Aug. 8-24, are tightly scheduled, and a rainy day can wreak havoc—particularly if the opening ceremony, perhaps China's best showcase of the Games, is a washout.

## **Authoritarian Eco Tech II- WMO**

- More than 50% of rain enhancement projects were conducted in China
  - State-led: 30 provinces and 2000 countries have Weather Modification Office.
  - WM equipments are fixed in specific spots and conducted regularly, and some provinces have aircrafts
